CLOSING DATE TO SUBMIT ENTRIES IS THURSDAY APRIL 29, 2010.

No phone entries will be accepted! All entries must be completed in full and received by 5:00 p.m. on **Thursday April 29, 2010 at the Secretary's address.** Make checks payable to the GSPCO and please include your phone no. and email address on your entry. The running order will be available and emailed no later than **Friday April 30th**. Note the later closing date of **April 29th**.

The grounds will be available beginning at 12:00 noon the day prior to our event and must be cleared by 12:00 noon the day after.

Parking for trailers and campers is on the level grounds on the entrance side of the club house. There is no parking on the driveway in. The driveway must be kept clear at all times.

Camping is allowed on the grounds but there are no electric hookups. Dogs and horses may be staked out using your own equipment. Do not attach dogs or horses to any building, structure or trees on the grounds.

Trash removal is everyone's responsibility. Please remove your own trash and recyclables.

Food prepared by GSPCO Chef Mark DiRienzo will be available on Saturday and Sunday. Water and soda will be available for sale. Bring water for your dogs and horses.

RUNNING ORDER

The Junior Hunt Test will run on a separate course from the Master and Senior Hunt Tests. Junior and Master are scheduled to start at 8:00 am.

Running order will be e-mailed after the draw to those entries with a valid e-mail address on their entry form.

COURSES AND BIRDS

All tests will run a single course with a bird field. Quail will be used but Pheasants, and Chukars may be present.

PRIZES

Standard AKC Rosettes to all passing dogs.

OPTIONAL EVENT ALLOWANCES

Usages of tracking devices as specified by AKC rules and regulations will be permitted during these events.

IMPORTANT NOTICES REGARDING THE EVENT DAY

Please check in with the test secretary upon arriving on the test grounds. An outer blaze orange jacket, shirt, or vest must be worn by all persons that enter the course or bird field during senior and master tests. The hunting test grounds will be the whole of the Oak Ridge property. All live fire on the hunting test grounds the **entire day of the test** must be supervised by the Captain of the Gun.

Please notify the test secretary if you handled a dog that passed and were not listed as handler on the entry form. The AKC requires accurate handler recording for dogs with qualifying scores.

Please dispose of dead birds and dog waste in designated areas.

APPRENTICE JUDGE OPPORTUNITIES

The German Shorthaired Pointer Club of Ohio supports those striving to become a hunting test judge. Please contact the event secretary if you would like to apprentice judge. Apprentice positions are limited to one per event.

AKC JUNIOR HANDLER PROGRAM

The German Shorthaired Pointer Club of Ohio encourages handlers ages 18 and under to participate in the American Kennel Club's® Junior Handler program. Visit http://www.akc.org/kids_juniors **before the event** for more information and to obtain a **junior handler number**. Please notify the test secretary at check in that a Junior Handler is handling the entry as additional paperwork is required at the event.

IMPORTANT NOTICES REGARDING ENTRIES

Entries will close at 5:00 PM local time, Thursday, April 29, 2010 with the test secretary at 14221 GAR Hwy, Chardon, Ohio. Drawing will take place at 5:30 PM local time Thursday, April 29, 2010 at the same address.

Entries limited to the number of dogs that can be run during available daylight hours. Entries will close when this limit is reached if this occurs prior to the specified closing time. Those entries received after said limit has been reached will be placed on an alternate (waiting) list according to postmarked date of received entry, and entrant will be notified of this.

Entries open to all AKC pointing breeds six months of age or over on May 1 & 2, 2009 respectively that are part of an AKC registered litter or that have been individually registered with AKC. Bitches in season are not eligible to participate.

Entries must be on official AKC Field Trial or Hunt Test entry form (enclosed.) **Phone, fax, or e-mail entries will not be accepted. No entry shall specify any conditions as to its acceptance.**

Entries that are incomplete (including unsigned entry forms) do not constitute a valid entry and will be returned. An entry form must be filled out for each dog **and** for each day entered.

Entries without correct fees (including returned checks and checks dated after the closing date) do not constitute a valid entry and will be returned. Fees must be payable in U.S. funds. A \$25 service charge will be applied for each returned check.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that the dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the test committee.

Entry fees will be refunded for bitches in season if the test secretary receives such a request in writing before the dog is called to the line.

Breakfast, lunch and liquid refreshments for human consumption will be available both days for a small fee. Please bring drinking water for your dogs and horses.

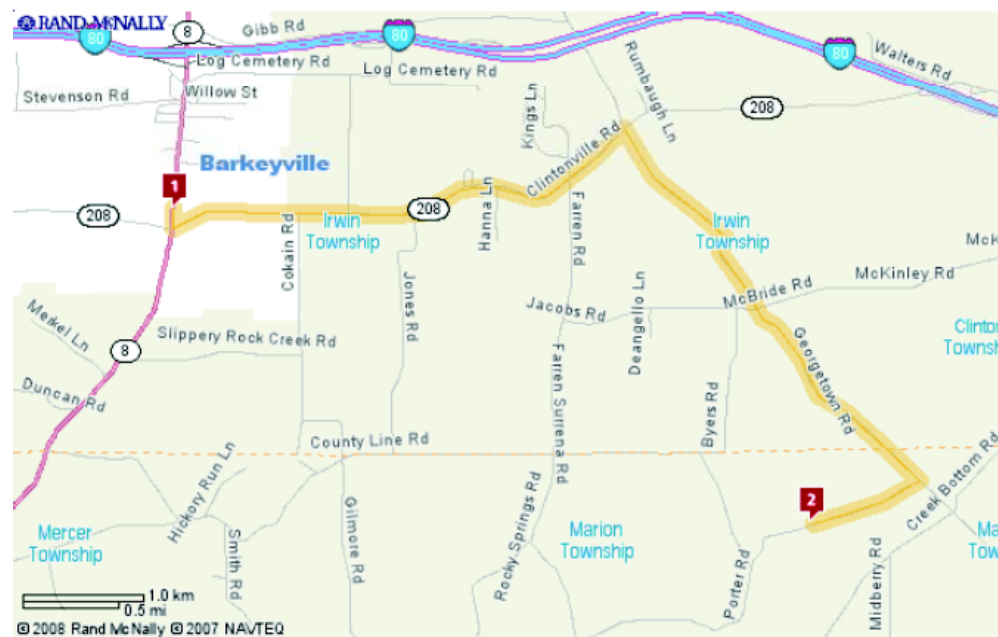
Primitive Camping on Site

FROM I- 80 (West): Exit at Barkeyville, PA

Go South on PA-8 (Pittsburgh Rd, William Flinn Hwy) 0.7 miles, Turn left onto PA-208 (Clintonville Rd) go 2.5 miles, Turn right onto Georgetown Rd (street becomes Windy Point Rd) go 2.4 miles, Turn right onto Porter Rd go approx. 0.6 miles. You are at 555 Porter Rd.

FROM I- 80 (East):

I-80 to exit 35 (308 Clintonville, old exit 4). Go South on 308 towards Murrinsville - 3.0 miles. Turn Rt on Windy Pointe Road (**no sign for Windy Pointe Rd. but sign on Lt side for SR 1005, Blue trailer on Rt corner**). Go 1.6 miles to Porter Road and take a left. Go 0.3 miles to property entrance on Right.

FROM ROUTE 8

Route 8 to Harrisville, PA (approximately 5 miles South of I-80) Go right (East) on Highway 58 (approximately 7 miles) to Highway 308 (W. Sunbury Road). Turn Left (North), go between 6/10's and 7/10's of a mile to Windy Pointe Road (no sign for Windy Pointe Rd. but sign on Rt side for SR 1005, Blue trailer on Lt. corner), turn left. Go 1.6 miles to Porter Road and take a left. 0.3 miles to property entrance on Right.
