CLOSING DATE TO SUBMIT ENTRIES IS Saturday April 10, 2010!

We are accepting mail-in entries only. **All entries must be completed in full and received by 7:00 pm (ET) by Saturday April 10, 2010. Make checks payable to: GSPCO.**

The grounds will be available beginning at 12:00 (noon) the day prior to our event.

Parking should be preferably along the woods line beyond the barn, the area next to the fence below the house, and the area directly in front of the back porch. The front (deck side) and side yard of the clubhouse should be kept clear of vehicles, horses and stakeout chains. The driveway also should be left open at all times. A diagram is posted on the bulletin board. Please unload your horses in the parking lot as the parking area may be soft and we do not want the grounds torn up. We are responsible for repairing any area torn up by a trailer or a truck getting stuck.

Camping: Electric hookups are available along the tree line behind the barn. **The cost for electric hookup is \$5 per day.** This fee will be collected by the event secretary. GSPCO is responsible for the cost of any repairs needed, due to damage that occurs during our Field Trial, so **PLEASE DO NOT ATTACH DOGS OR HORSES TO ELECTRICAL EQUIPMENT, DECK OR PORCH.**

GSPCO is responsible for removing all trash from the Brittany grounds after our trial. Therefore, it is your responsibility to remove your garbage from the Brittany Grounds – **DO NOT** leave your trash in the trash barrels on the grounds. Please take it home with you. Thanks for your cooperation on this policy.

Horses: Handlers will need to make their own arrangements for horses. The GSPCO will not be responsible for providing horses.

Food: A Light Breakfast and Lunch will be available on the grounds daily. On Saturday evening, we will have Happy Hour, our awards and raffle, with lasagna for dinner.

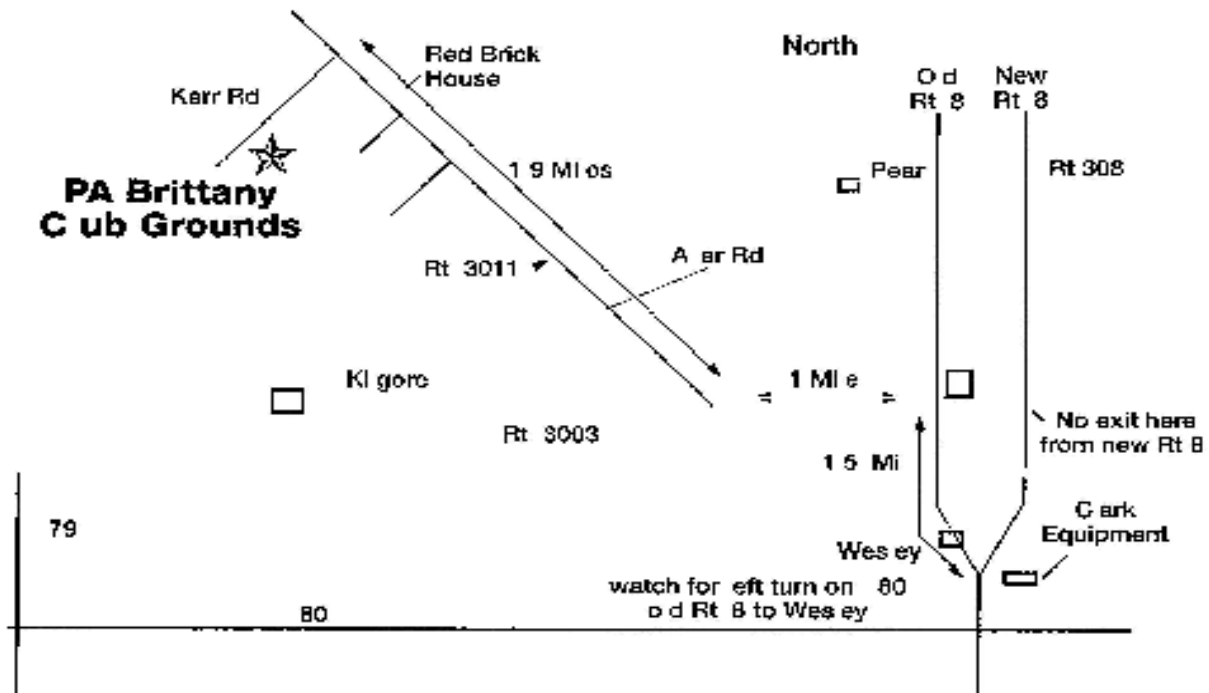
Water: Water available for horses and dogs. Bring drinking water for human consumption.
