Featured Member Profile: Dennis Meinke joined 1988

He has raised and trained German Shorthaired Pointers for Field Trials, Hunt Tests and hunting since 1981. He has owned 25 adult GSPs and currently owns three with a litter due in September. He has been a member of the GSPCO since 1988. He was first involved with GSPCO's Hunters Trials held at Grand River Wildlife Area. Later he got involved in the clubs AKC Hunt tests and Field Trials and has helped run many of these events. He has also been known to makes a few Snicker Doodle cookies for these

events.

Many hours per week are devoted to training dogs and keeping them in condition. He is the President and Field Trial Chairman at the Crooked Creek Conservation Club in Hartsgrove, Ohio where the GSPCO training days are held. He is an experienced AKC

Hunt test Judge. In addition to raising and training dogs Dennis is also an avid hunter, both with his dogs for birds and for big game animals such as Deer, Elk, Bear, Antelope and Caribou. Dennis also owns 90 acres in Ashtabula, which he maintains for wildlife

habitat, personal recreation. He built a 5acre deep water pond and a 3 acre shallow water wet lands. In his free time and between hunting seasons Dennis enjoys Lake Erie walleye and perch fishing.

Skunk Odor Removal Recipe






- 1 quart 3 percent hydrogen peroxide

Exercise and Conditioning in the Heat

The dog days of summer are upon us, and while we suffer through this mid-summer heat, our dogs suffer with us. Our breed still needs exercise to stay sane and fit even in the 90+ degree weather. Read the following key points to exercising your dogs safely in the warm weather.

Surface: The drought and excessive heat is making the ground like concrete, and can quickly compromise the feet. Watch for sores, blisters, cuts, etc...

Time of Day, Temperature, and Weather: Exercising a dog early in the morning or late at evening is ideal. Dogs don't release excessive heat through sweating, like people, and are subject to overheating. An overheated dog will drool, pant excessively, become legthargic, gums may appear pale, skin may not be so elastic as normal.

Age: and body condition: Young pups and senior dogs are more susceptible to overheating than a dog in its prime.

Cooling and hydration: Dogs cool from the bottom up, so putting them in a tub of cool water and getting their belly wet a more effective than dumping water on their head. An avg. GSP should consume approximately half a gallon of water a day, but may need more in the summer.



Don't forget to hydrate! Have fresh water available to animals at all times in the summer months.




