DIRECTIONS:

FROM I-70 EAST: take the state route 93 Exit (Adamsville) North approximately 10 miles to the village of Adamsville. Continue North on State Route 208 and follow approximately 4.6 miles to Keyes Rd. Turn Right (North) onto Keyes Rd. Continue 1.4 miles and turn Left (West) on Stone Church Rd. Follow 1.76 miles to entrance.

OR:

FROM US I-70: take US route 60 to state route 208 in Dresden to McLaughlin Hill Rd. Turn Left on McLaughlin Hill Rd. Follow to Stone Church Rd and turn right. *****THIS ROUTE CONSISTS OF WIDER ROADS WITH LESSER GRADES. RT 666 IS NOT BIG RIG FRIENDLY. DO NOT TAKE RT 666**

FROM STATE ROUTE 16: take state route 60 South exit (Dresden). Follow SR 60 S for approximately 2.6 miles to SR 208 at Dresden. Turn Left (East) onto SR 208 and follow through the village. When you cross the bridge over the Muskingum River, turn North onto SR 208. Follow SR 208 for 2.8 miles to McLaughlin Rd (top of hill). Turn Left (Northeast) onto McLaughlin Rd and follow for .7 miles to Stone Church Rd. Turn Right (East) onto Stone Church Rd and follow .4 miles to entrance.
