Kyle's Hightailing Luke 2.13.01-12.8.07 Owned by Dr. Robert & Amy Reynolds

Luke was named Field Trial Sire of 2017 by the German Shorthaired Pointer Club of America. This is the second time that he has received this honor.

It is awarded to the dog that has sired the most Field Champions for that year.

Although he died at a young age and was bred sparingly, his progeny has had outstanding success in the field.

He was a son of Field Trial Hall of Fame KJ's Hightailing Saddle, out of a daughter of National Field Champion Heide's Mighty City Slicker. Luke has produced 11 Field Champions in the American Kennel Club. On the American Field side, he has produced 19 Champions with 140 placements.

Luke had 12 American Field placements. He was a 3time National German Shorthaired Pointer Club of America (NGSPA) All-Age Pheasant Champion, and National German Pointing Dog Association (NGPDA) All-Age Champion Runner-Up. An admirable record in his short lifetime, but due to the benefit of frozen semen his legacy lives on.

Our specialty is held in conjunction with an all-breed show weekend starting on Thursday of the show week and continuing through Friday, Saturday and Sunday with our German Shorthaired Pointer Specialty held on Saturday along with the Ashtabula Kennel Clubs all-breed show. As a club we support the entry on Friday and Sunday by offering trophies for many wins and placements.

I would like to explain for those of you not familiar with dog shows how the entries and classes work. The classes are separated by sex. Dogs show first. There are 8 regular classes offered in every show. At a specialty show additional classes may or may not be offered. We offer 3 additional classes. Veteran classes for dogs and bitches 7 years of age or older. Hunting Classes for dogs and bitches that have earned a Junior, Senior or Master Hunter Title under AKC rules. And Field Trial Classes for dogs and bitches that have placed in an AKC Licensed or Member Field Trial or have received a Judge's Award of Merit

After the entries in dogs (males) are judged, each class separately, all the 1st place winners come together in the ring and one is selected by the judge as Winners Dog. This is the only dog to receive points towards their championship. This is repeated again with the bitch classes. After the class judging is completed the Breed entrants enter the ring with the winner's dog and bitch bringing up the rear as they are specifically placed behind all the BOB entrants. From these entrants a selection will be made for Best of Breed (BOB), Best of Opposite Sex to BOB (BOS), Best of Winners (BOW), Select Dog and Select Bitch. Any dog (or bitch) can be put up for Best of Breed, although winning that from the classes is not common and certainly not with an entry of as many Champions and Grand Champions as we've had in the past.

That concludes the breed judging and the dog/bitch that was selected as Best of Breed goes on to compete in the Sporting Group Judging. 1st thru 4th are selected in the Group but only the 1st in group dog/bitch continues to compete for Best in Show and Reserve Best in Show.

The 2018 GSPCO Specialty will be held July 14[,] 2018. Shorthairs usually show early so plan to be there by 8 am if you want to see the breed judging. See you there!

LADIES DAYS ONLY SILVER DOLLAR SPORTSMEN'S CLUB 5040 Secrest Rd., Wooster, OH

To meet the demand and interest of more women in the shooting sports and hunting fields, the Silver Dollar Sportsmen's Club will be holding several "Ladies Days Only" events. The goal is to take women to the point of being confident with firearms and hunting. Participants will receive orange hats, ear plugs and safety glasses. Programs will repeat in 2019. If you miss one, you can pick it up next year.

The first will be May 12th, 8:00 a.m. – 12 noon, Firearm Safety. In this course women will learn gun and archery safety. Cost is \$45.00/participant. Bring your own firearm and/or bow, if you have them. If not, we have several to loan you for the day.

June 9th, same times, participants will learn how to shoot trap and have ample time on trap lanes with instructors. Bring your own 12 or 20 gauge shotgun. There will be several for loan that day if you don't have your own. Cost will be \$25.00/per participant.

On July 14th participants will learn archery. Time will be 8:00 a.m. – 12 noon. After a brief demo, participants will practice with instructors. Cost will be \$25.00.

September 22nd will be spent at the undercover pistol range. After a brief safety lesson, participants will practice shooting handguns. Time again will be 8:00 a.m. – 12 noon, rain or shine. There will be several loaner handguns. Cost will be \$25.00.

The last event of the fall will be a **dog/bird hunt on October 13th**. With experienced dog and handlers, participants will be taken on an actual bird hunts to learn how the dogs and handlers work together. **Cost will be \$25.00**.
