looking for advice, kennel space and networking. We applaud Pam for her


hard work and dedication.

Bottom Crust

- 1 cup melted margarine
- 2 cups of flour
- ½ cup of powdered sugar

- Pack into 9 x 13 pan
- Bake @ 350 for 15 minutes

Mix

- 2 cups of sugar
- 4 tablespoons flour
- 1 teaspoon baking powder

Then Add


- 4 eggs


