Good Sportsman Rules

- 1. "The "Golden Rule" show respect for your competitor and day to the seandard that you expect it for
- 2. Have a good understanding and appreciation of the rules of the sport. The spirit of good sportsmanship depends on conforming to the intent of the role and not looking for the loop hele.
- 3. Enjoy yourself and encourage enjoyment of others.
- 4. Take responsibility for your actions.
- 5. Recognize and appreciate good performances, especially by your opponent.
- 6. Exhibit respect for the judges and officials.
- 7. Expect proper behavior from yourself and others.


